KEY THEMES

- Dominion PUR-2025-00032 serves three Culpeper data-center campuses, \$253.7M, May 2028
- PointOne pivots Remington Technology Park to fuel cells after Fauquier gas-plant denial
- Reliance commissions first 120 MW of Jamnagar AI backbone by end-2026
- Pennsylvania credits Fast Track permitting for Amazon's \$20B Salem and Falls Township campuses

Inside PUR-2025-00032: Dominion's Remington Rebuild and the Culpeper data-center load it serves

Briefing assembled from one feature (Dominion/Remington Virginia transmission) and two secondaries (Reliance-Meta Jamnagar; Pennsylvania-Amazon Fast Track). Status degraded: all corporate/agency entities returned no_match in copilot_analysis, so entity_anchors covers only resolved counties and states. No auto_signals on any input, so the 'Today's filings worth a look' section is omitted. No also_today stories. Absence-framing in the feature synthesis (e.g. 'not established in cited materials', 'did not surface a FERC filing', 'permit trail thinner than the headline') was dropped or converted to verified-vs-listing contrasts per fact-forward discipline. The single permitted research-scoped caveat appears once on the Remington/Dominion commitment point. Williams Q3 2030 normalized to calendar Q3 2030. Williams fiscal anchor consumed (calendar-year FY). PointOne 304 MW operator-current vs 400/425 MW secondary listings presented as a sourced-variance contrast, not an absence.
