## Inside Realty Income's \$1.4B, 45% stake in a Northern Virginia hyperscale JV

Realty Income put dollar figures on its new hyperscale data center bet on June 30, 2026. The company launched a programmatic joint venture with Cloud Capital and an unnamed global institutional investor. Realty Income expects to invest [up to \\$1.4 billion for a 45% common-equity stake](#). The initial seed portfolio is three Northern Virginia data center assets valued at [over \\$6.0 billion](#).

- [Realty Income forms hyperscale JV with Cloud Capital](#) – Three Northern Virginia seed assets, 15- to 20-year triple-net leases, with CloudHQ providing property and development management.
- [PointOne revises Remington power plan to 488 fuel cells](#) – PointOne's Fauquier County campus swaps 13 gas turbines for 488 natural-gas solid oxide fuel cells; a July 9 Board hearing is set.
- [Google reports 37% load growth alongside 1 GW of demand response](#) – 2025 electricity demand rose 37%; Google integrated 1 GW of demand response into U.S. utility contracts and signed 12+ GW of clean energy.
- [Tata Communications commits \\$152m to India-Singapore subsea build](#) – MIST (Mumbai-Singapore) and Project CS (Chennai-Singapore) link into Tata's terrestrial fiber reaching 100+ data centres nationwide.

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
